## **Annual Report (2016) of the Spanish National Committee**

During 2016, the Spanish Committee for History of Art (CEHA) organised its 21st edition of the national conference in Santander on September 20 to 23. Under the title "La formación artística: creadores, historiadores, espectadores" (The artistic training: artists, historians and public), more than 200 attendants presented works from different perspectives and methodologies, from local and regional cases to global phenomena, or from Big Data to 3D surveys. During the event, the prize to the best postdoctoral paper was given to Fátima Bethencourt Pérez, and to Mª Ángeles Pérez-Martín, for the best predoctoral proposal. At the same time, the homage was given to Dr. D. Alfonso Rodríguez Gutiérrez de Ceballos.

CEHA has also published the biography of Manuel Gómez Moreno Martínez, as part of the book series titled *Colección Maestros de la Historia del Arte* (Collection "Masters of the History of Art"), written by José Manuel Gómez-Moreno Calera.
